## CHAPTER 9.

## STATE ROAD.

AN ACT to locate a State road from Glenwood, Mills county, to Quincy, in Adams county.

SEC. 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the commission-State of Iowa, That David H. Solomon, of Mills county, era. Amos C. Lowe, of Montgomery county, and John R. Calvin, of Adams county, be and they are hereby appointed Commissioners, to locate a State road, beginning at Glenwood in the county of Mills, thence easterly by the nearest and best route, by Frankford, in Montgomery county, to Quincy, in Adams county.

Time and place of meeting.

SEC. 2. That the Commissioners thus appointed shall on the first Tuesday of October, or within thirty days thereafter, meet at Glenwood, and after taking with them the necessary assistants and being duly qualified proceed to the discharge of their duty.

How paid.

SEC. 3. The commissioners, surveyor and assistants above specified shall receive pay for their services in establishing said road in accordance with the provision of law in such case made and provided.

Take effect.

SEC. 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the Glenwood Weekly Times.
