

CHAPTER 28.

AN ACT to amend Chapter 139 of the laws of the State of Iowa, passed at the regular session of the 5th General Assembly.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa,* Amendments. That the 11th section of the 139th Chapter of the laws of the State of Iowa, passed at the regular session of the 5th General Assembly, be amended by striking out the word "and" after the word "Ringgold," and inserting the words "and Union," after the word "Adams," so that said section as amended will read as follows:—The counties of Fremont, Mills, Page, Taylor, Montgomery, Adams and Union, shall constitute the eleventh district, and have one Senator.

SEC. 2. This act to be in force after its publication in the Iowa Capital Reporter and Republican. Take effect.

CHAPTER 29.

RAIL ROAD STOCK.

AN ACT to authorize certain Towns therein named, to subscribe to the Capital Stock of Railroad Corporations, and to issue bonds to aid in the construction of Railroads.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa,* Towns authorized. That the city of Lyons, in Clinton county, and the towns of Maquoketa and Bellevue in Jackson county, and Anamosa, in Jones county, towns incorporated under the laws of this State, may subscribe to the capital stock of any railroad corporation, legally incorporated To subscribe stock.
