Survey & plat. Sec. 2. That on the application of the said owners, it shall be the duty of said County Judge, to appoint a Surveyor to survey and mark out a plat of the same, and make return thereof to said judge as soon as practicable, whose duty it shall be to have the same recorded.

compensation Sec. 3. The Surveyor appointed shall be allowed such compensation as the said County Judge shall appoint, which shall be borne by the said owners of said lots.

Take effect. SEC. 4. This act to take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

Approved July 12th, 1856.

CHAPTER 43.

RECORDS.

AN ACT to authorized the County Judge of Jackson county, to transcribe a portion of the Probate Records of said county.

Transcribe research Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa, That the Judge of Jackson county is hereby authorized and required to transcribe into well bound books, and index, all the Probate Records of said county of Jackson, that are contained in small paper covered books, and made prior to July 1st, 1851.

Certified.

SEC. 2. That such transcribed record shall be certified by said judge, to be a true and correct transcript of the original record, and after such certificate is thereunto attached, the said transcript, or any part thereof, shall have the same binding effect as the original, and such transcript or a certified copy thereof, shall be evidence of equal dignity with the original of the matters and things therein contained.

Compensation Sec. 3. That said County Judge be authorized to receive for said work ten cents for every huhdred words, in addition to his present salary, to be paid by Jackson county.

Take effect. Sec. 4. This act to take effect from and after its passage. Approved, July 15th, 1856.
