# LAWS OF IOWA.

## CHAPTER 1.

#### RECORDS OF APPANOOSE.

AN ACT to authorize the County Judge of Appaneouse County, to transcribe a portion of the Records of said County, and to legalize the same.

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State Transcribe of Iowa, That the Judge of Appaneose county is hereby authorized and required to transcribe and index all the Re-All Records. cords of said county of Appaneose, that yet remain in unbound books.

§ 2. That all the Records heretofore transcribed by order Made legal, of the County Judge of said County, are hereby made lawful:

§ 8. That said County Judge be authorized to receive Compensation for said work, ten cents for every hundred words, in addition to his present salary.

§ 4. This Act to take effect and be in force from and Take effect. after its passage.
