## CHAPTER 23.

### GOSPORT.

AN ACT to change the name of Newton, in Marion county, to Gosport.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa,* That the name of Newton, in Marion <sup>Name changed</sup> county, be, and the same is hereby changed to Gosport.

§ 2. That this act shall take effect from and after its <sup>Take effect.</sup> publication according to law, and a copy of the same being recorded in the office of the Recorder of Deeds of Marion <sup>Record</sup> County, Iowa.

## CHAPTER 24.

### JUSTICE IN KNOXVILLE.

AN ACT to provide for the election of an additional Justice of the Peace in Knoxville, Marion County, Iowa.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the* <sup>Justice of the Peace and Constable.</sup> *State of Iowa,* That at the August election in 1855, and at <sup>Election of.</sup> the April election in 1857, and every two years thereafter, there shall be elected one additional Justice of the Peace, and one Constable, in the township of Knoxville, Marion County, Iowa.
