

CHAPTER 84.

ATTACHED,

AN ACT to attach the county of Cerro Gordo to the county of Floyd, for certain purposes.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa*, That the county Cerro Gordo is hereby attached to the county of Floyd, for election, revenue and Judicial purposes. attached to Cerro Gordo, attached to Floyd county.

§ 2. All acts and parts of acts, in conflict with this Act Repealed. are hereby repealed.

§ 8. This Act to be in force from and after its publication in the Iowa City Reporter and Republican. Take effect.

CHAPTER 85.

OSKALOOSA CITY.

AN ACT to incorporate Oskaloosa.

SEC. 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa*, That the corporate limits of the city of Oskaloosa, be, and are hereby established, as follows: commencing at the north-east corner of the south-east quarter of section 13, in township 75 north, range 16 west; thence east to the north-west corner of the north-east quarter, of the south-west quarter of section 18, in township 75 north, range 15 west; thence south to the south-east corner of Houts' ad- City limits.
