CHAPTER 88.

STATE ROAD.

AN ACT to locate and establish a certain State Road therein named.

- Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the Commission-State of Iowa, That Simon Archer, of Linn county, James ers. Buchanan and Cyrus Sanders, of Johnson county, be, and they are hereby appointed Commissioners, to locate and es-Lisbon to Iotablish a State Road from Lisbon, in Linn county, to Iowa wa City. City, in Johnson county.
- § 2. The Commissioners hereby appointed shall meet at Time & place Iowa City, on the first Tuesday in April next, or within of meeting. thirty days thereafter, who, after being sworn to the faithful discharge of their duties, shall take to their aid necessary assistance, and proceed to locate and establish such road:

 Provided, the expense of locating said road shall be paid by Expense. the counties of Linn and Johnson.
- § 3. This act to be in force from and after its publica-Take effect. tion in the Iowa City newspapers.
