CHAPTER 137.

TERMS OF COURT,

AN ACT to change the time of holdin Courts in the counties comprising the sixth and seventh Judicial Districts.

Terms in the 6th Judicial District.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa, That the terms of the court shall be held in the county of Fremont, the first Mondays in March and September. In the county of Page on the fourth Monday in March and September. In the county of Taylor on the Thursday after the fourth Monday of March and September. In the county of Adams on the first Mondays in April and October. In the county of Union on the Thursday after the first Monday in April and October. In the county of Guthrie on the second Monday in April and October. In thecounty of Cass on the Thursday after the second Monday in April and October. In the county of Mills on the second Monday in March and September. In the county of Pottawattamie on the first Monday in April and October. In the county of Harrison on the first Monday of May and November. the county of Shelby on the Thursday after the first Monday in May and November. In the county of Woodbury on the first Monday in September, and in all other counties at such time and place as the Judge may appoint

Terms in the 7th Judicial Distric.

Take effect.

§ 2. This Act to be in force from and after its publication in the Iowa Capital Reporter and Iowa Republican.
