

CHAPTER 63
ADJUTANT GENERAL

H. F. 39

AN ACT to amend section four hundred sixty-seven and forty-two hundredths (467.42), code, 1939, relating to the appointment of the adjutant general by the Governor.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 SECTION 1. Section four hundred sixty-seven and forty-two hun-
2 dredths (467.42), Code, 1939, is hereby amended by striking out the
3 comma (,) in line six (6) thereof following the word "guard" and
4 inserting in lieu thereof a period (.), and striking out all the remain-
5 ing part of said sentence following the word "guard" in line six (6)
6 and inserting in lieu thereof the words "When a majority of the
7 general officers and regimental commanders of the National Guard
8 are in Federal Military service in time of war, said appointment shall
9 be made by the governor without such recommendation. The Adju-
10 tant General shall have the rank of Brigadier General and hold office
11 for a term of four (4) years."

1 SEC. 2. This act being deemed of immediate importance shall be in
2 full force and effect from and after its publication in the O'Brien
3 County Bell, a newspaper published at Primghar, Iowa, and in the
4 Spencer Times, a newspaper published at Spencer, Iowa.

PRIMARY ELECTION NOMINATION PAPERS

AN ACT to amend section five hundred forty-six (546), code, 1939, relating to the signatures to nomination papers.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 SECTION 1. Section five hundred forty-six (546), Code, 1939, is
2 amended by inserting the words "each of" after the word "in" in line
3 five (5) of paragraph two (2) of said section.
