- the commencement of each term the first two daily publications of said paper shall be furnished free by the publisher to any attorneys who shall request the clerk for the same."
- SEC. 4. Section ten thousand eight hundred thirty-seven (10837), Code, 1939, is amended by adding at the end of subsection one (1) the following: "Provided that in counties of one hundred sixty thousand or over the fee shall be two dollars, of which fifty cents shall be known and designated as journal publication fee, to be charged and collected for the purposes provided for in this act."
- 1 Section eleven thousand three hundred forty-nine (11349), Code, 1939, is amended by adding thereto the following: 2 3 the publication of the filing in the district court of the petitions as 4 herein provided for, and a charge on the basis of fifty cents for each 5 petition, shall be made once each month by the publisher thereof, presented to the clerk of the district court for verification and approv-7 al, and filed with the county auditor to be presented to the board of supervisors, which shall order the claim for such publications paid 8 9 from the district court funds.'
- SEC. 6. This act being deemed of immediate importance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication in the Daily Record, a newspaper published at Des Moines, Iowa, and the Daily Reporter, a newspaper published at Sioux City, Iowa.

## FINDING OF FACTS BY REFEREES

S. F. 73

AN ACT to amend section eleven thousand five hundred twenty-seven (11527), code, relating to the finding of facts by referees.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

SECTION 1. Section eleven thousand five hundred twenty-seven (11527), Code, 1939, is amended by striking from line one (1) the word, "reference" and inserting in lieu thereof the word, "referee".
