- an additional assessment against the lands and highways contained in such drainage district in the amount of 2% of the original assessment made by the Board of Supervisors of said County on November 20, 1944.
- SEC. 2. The State Comptroller is hereby authorized to issue his warrant to the above named party in the amount stated, and the State Treasurer is hereby directed to pay the same from the respective funds above specified.
- SEC. 3. The acceptance of said sum by the above named party shall be in full settlement of all claims against the State of Iowa growing out of the above described claim.

## CHAPTER 20

## MUSCATINE COUNTY DRAINAGE DISTRICT H. F. 178

AN ACT making an appropriation to Muscatine county, Iowa.

## Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

- SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to Muscatine County, Iowa, the sum of six thousand thirty-eight dollars and sixty-two cents (\$6038.62) in payment of special assessments for drainage purposes imposed upon lands owned by the state of Iowa in Drainage District No. 13 of Muscatine, Iowa.
- SEC. 2. The state comptroller is hereby authorized and directed to draw his warrant to the said county to which appropriation has been made under the provisions of this act and in the sum so appropriated and heretofore set out, in payment of said special assessment, and the treasurer of state is hereby authorized and directed to pay the same out of any funds in the state treasury not otherwise appropriated.
- SEC. 3. This appropriation represents the final payment on the basis of the old classification to Muscatine County for any assessment which it may levy against State owned land located within the boundaries of Drainage District No. 13 of Muscatine County. Any additional or new assessment which Muscatine County may levy against State owned land located within the boundaries of Drainage District No. 13 in Muscatine County can not be higher than the average assessment levied against privately owned lands in the district as a whole.
