CHAPTER 83

SHOOTING OVER RAILROAD RIGHT OF WAY

S. F. 67

AN ACT to amend section one hundred nine and fifty-four hundredths (109.54), code, 1946, relating to the shooting of a rifle on or across railroad right of way.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

- SECTION 1. Section one hundred nine and fifty-four hundredths
- (109.54), Code, 1946, is amended by striking the period (.) at the end thereof and adding the following: "or any railroad right of way.".
