CHAPTER 149

ORDNANCE PLANT AREA TO SCHOOL DISTRICT S. F. 118

AN ACT to amend section two hundred seventy-four point forty (274.40), code 1946, relating to the reorganization of school districts and the adjustment of boundary lines of school districts when lands are returned to private ownership after having been acquired by the federal government.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

- 1 Section 1. Section two hundred seventy-four point forty (274.40), 2 Code 1946, is hereby amended by adding thereto the following: "When-
- 3 ever real estate acquired by the United States government as provided
- 4 in section two hundred seventy-four point thirty-nine (274.39), Code
- 5 1946, is returned to private ownership through sale or otherwise the
- 6 County Board of Education of such county in which such land is located 7 shall have authority to adjust the boundary lines of contiguous school
- 8 districts in such manner as they may deem just and equitable so as
- 9 to include and make said real estate a part of the school districts to 10 which the land is contiguous, or to reorganize said real estate into a
- which the land is contiguous, or to reorganize said real estate into a separate school district as provided by law; provided, however, that
