- county library district shall not apply to any area receiving library service from any city or town library under the provisions of chapter three hundred seventy-eight (378), Code 1946, unless the petition for a county library district shall, in addition to the required signatures
- of electors, be signed by the governing body of the area receiving library service under contract.". 10
- SEC. 10. Chapter one hundred ninety-three (193), Acts of the Fifty-second General Assembly is hereby amended by adding thereto as a new paragraph the following:
- "Whenever a county library district is established the board of trustees thereof shall assume all the obligations of the existing con-5 tracts made by cities, towns, townships, school corporations or counties to receive library service from free public libraries.".
- SEC. 11. Section three hundred seventy-eight point fifteen 1 (378.15), Code 1946, is hereby amended by striking the word "onefourth" in line five (5) and inserting in lieu thereof the word "one".
- SEC. 12. Section four hundred four point five (404.5), Code 1946, is hereby amended by striking from line three (3) of subsection 2 twenty-one (21) the word "one-fourth" and substituting in lieu thereof the word "one".

CHAPTER 164

WATER FRONT LAND IN CITIES AND TOWNS H. F. 19

AN ACT to amend section three hundred eighty-four point three (384.3), Code 1946, relating to the purchase or acquisition by condemnation of lands by dock boards in cities and towns.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

- SECTION 1. Subsection two (2) of section three hundred eighty-four point three (384.3), Code 1946, is amended by inserting after the word "harbor," in line seven (7) the words "water front,". 3
- This Act being deemed of immediate importance shall take effect from and after its publication in the Telegraph Herald, a newspaper published at Dubuque, Iowa, and the Dyersville Commercial, a newspaper published at Dyersville, Iowa.
