- SEC. 3. Paragraph (a) of subsection thirteen (13) of section four hundred eleven point six (411.6), Code 1946, is hereby amended by striking from line four (4) thereof the word "thirty" and by inserting in lieu thereof the word "fifty". 3

CHAPTER 183

MUNICIPAL COURT BAILIFFS

S. F. 322

AN ACT to amend section four hundred eleven point three (411.3), Code 1946, relating to retirement systems and providing that same apply to deputy bailiffs in municipal courts with civil service rights in cities having a population of one hundred twenty-five thousand (125,000) or more, and providing for assessments to be paid by deputy bailiffs of municipal courts with civil service rights in cities having a population of one hundred twenty-five thousand (125,000) or more one hundred twenty-five thousand (125,000) or more.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

SECTION 1. Section four hundred eleven point three (411.3), Code 1946, is amended by adding an additional section thereto, as follows: "Any deputy bailiff of municipal courts in cities having a population of one hundred twenty-five thousand (125,000) or more, who after having passed the required civil service examination, and was certified and appointed as such, shall for the purpose of this chapter be deemed a member of the Police Department within the purview of section four hundred eleven point one (411.1), Code 1946, and is hereby given the right, if he so desires, to become a member of the 10 Police Retirement System as set forth in this chapter by first paying to the treasurer of said fund three per cent (3%) of the total salary 11 12 which was received by said deputy bailiff to the time of coming under the provisions of this chapter, and in addition thereto, shall be required to pay annually in monthly installments to the treasurer of 13 14 said fund an amount equal to the rates provided by section four hundred eleven point eight (411.8), Code 1946, so long as said deputy 15 16 bailiff shall be employed as such." 17

SEC. 2. All laws or parts of laws in conflict herewith insofar as they conflict, are hereby repealed.
