CHAPTER 1

DEPARTMENTAL APPROPRIATIONS

AN ACT to appropriate from the general fund of the state of Iowa for the biennium beginning July 1, 1953, and ending June 30, 1955, funds for various departments and various divisions thereof, of the state of Iowa, for the purposes provided by law, and to amend section six hundred five point one (605.1), Code 1950, relating to salaries of judges of the district court, and section six hundred five point two (605.2), Code 1950, relating to expenses of the justices of the supreme court.

 10 Capitol building shall be transferred to the History and Archives build-
 11 ing, there to be placed in substantially the same arrangements, under
 12 the direction of the curator, and the executive council is hereby au-
 13 thorized and directed to make such transfer. The curator is hereby
 14 directed to make adequate space available and to prepare a suitable and
 15 proper display in the History and Archives Building depicting the part
 16 of the State of Iowa in the War of the Rebellion, listing the engage-
 17 ments in which Iowa troops participated, stating the Iowa communities
 18 from which the various units were recruited, and, by pictures, maps,
 19 trophies, mementoes and all visual aids possible, tell to the people of
 20 Iowa the glorious history of our state in the Civil War.
