## CHAPTER 4

### BOARD OF CONTROL CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS

H. F. 487

AN ACT to appropriate funds for certain capital improvements for institutions under the board of control including construction of new buildings, repairs, improvements, replacements or alterations, and providing for the joint control of the expenditure thereof by the board of control and the budget and financial control committee.

*Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*

1 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated from the general fund of  
2 the state to the board of control the sum of three million seven hun-  
3 dred thousand dollars (\$3,700,000.00) to be used in the following  
4 manner to-wit:

5 To supplement any of the appropriations for capital improvement  
6 items included in chapter three (3), Acts of the Fifty-first General  
7 Assembly, in chapter twelve (12), Acts of the Fifty-second General  
8 Assembly and in chapter three (3), Acts of the Fifty-third General  
9 Assembly, or for any other capital expenditure the board of control  
10 may deem necessary for the proper and necessary function of any  
11 institution under its jurisdiction.

1 SEC. 2. Before any of the funds herein appropriated shall be ex-  
2 pended it shall be determined by the state board of control with the  
3 approval of the budget and financial control committee that the ex-  
4 penditure shall be for the best interest of the state.

1 SEC. 3. When contracts, plans and specifications or plan of opera-  
2 tion for an improvement for which funds are herein appropriated has  
3 been accepted by the state board of control, and approved and certi-  
4 fied by the budget and financial control committee, the state comp-  
5 troller shall allocate the funds for each such improvement.

1 SEC. 4. The provisions of all acts or statutes in conflict or incon-  
2 sistent with the provisions of this act are hereby repealed.

1 SEC. 5. The board of control and the budget and financial control  
2 committee are hereby authorized to obtain federal grants to the state  
3 to be used in connection with the funds above appropriated or di-  
4 verted for such construction purpose.

1 SEC. 6. The governor and budget and financial control committee  
2 are hereby directed to transfer from the special reserve fund created  
3 by the provisions of chapter forty-four (44), Acts of the Fifty-third

4 General Assembly, a sufficient fund to provide for the specific alloca-  
 5 tions required to be made by the comptroller under this act, unless  
 6 the comptroller and governor certify to the budget and financial con-  
 7 trol committee that in their judgment there are sufficient funds avail-  
 8 able in the general fund for the operation of state government at that  
 9 time so as to make the use of the special reserve fund unnecessary  
 10 during said biennium.

## CHAPTER 5

### BOARD OF CONTROL FUNDS TRANSFERRED

H. F. 486

AN ACT transferring all unallocated balances of the appropriation made by chapter three (3), Acts of the Fifty-first General Assembly, to the state board of control, including all subsequent transfers made thereto, to the board of control capital improvement fund created by chapter three (3), Acts of the Fifty-third General Assembly.

*Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*

1 SECTION 1. On the effective date of this Act there shall be trans-  
 2 ferred the balance of any funds appropriated to the state board of  
 3 control by chapter three (3), Acts of the Fifty-first General Assem-  
 4 bly, including all subsequent transfers made thereto, to the fund cre-  
 5 ated and established by chapter three (3), Acts of the Fifty-third  
 6 General Assembly. The balances, when transferred, shall be subject  
 7 to the same use and control on expenditure as provided in chapter  
 8 three (3), Acts of the Fifty-third General Assembly.

1 SEC. 2. The balance of the foregoing appropriated funds directed  
 2 herein to be transferred shall be such funds remaining from the appro-  
 3 priation made by chapter three (3), Acts of the Fifty-first General  
 4 Assembly, including subsequent transfers made thereto, but exclud-  
 5 ing therefrom amounts which have heretofore been expressly allocated  
 6 to a specific project through appropriate action by the budget and  
 7 financial control committee and the comptroller.

1 SEC. 3. The comptroller is hereby directed to make the transfer on  
 2 the books in his office and to certify to the treasurer of the state the  
 3 fact that the transfers herein directed have been made and have been  
 4 so entered upon the books in his office.

1 SEC. 4. This Act being deemed of immediate importance, shall be  
 2 in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication in  
 3 the Centerville Daily Iowegian and Citizen, a newspaper published at  
 4 Centerville, Iowa, and in The Traer Star Clipper, a newspaper pub-  
 5 lished at Traer, Iowa.
