because of the fact that the claimant has made prior arrangements for 4 funeral expenses in an amount not to exceed five hundred dollars.' 5

This bill, having remained with the governor three days (Sunday excepted), the General Assembly being in session, has become a law this 3rd day of May, 1957. MELVIN D. SYNHORST, Secretary of State.
