#### CHAPTER 123

#### RELIEF FOR THE POOR

# H. F. 77

AN ACT to amend section two hundred fifty-two point twenty-seven (252.27) relating to relief for the poor.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 SECTION 1. Section two hundred fifty-two point twenty-seven 2 (252.27), Code 1954, is hereby amended by inserting a period after 3 the word "money" in line four (4) and striking the following from 4 lines four (4) to seven (7), inclusive, ", and shall not exceed two 5 dollars per week for each person for whom relief is furnished, ex-6 clusive of medical attendance" and inserting in lieu thereof the fol-10wing: "The amount of assistance issued to meet the needs of the 8 person shall be determined by standards of assistance established by 9 the county boards of supervisors."

## CHAPTER 124

## VOCATIONAL EDUCATION

## S. F. 39

AN ACT to amend chapter two hundred fifty-eight (258), Code 1954, relating to vocational education.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

- 2 (258.1), Code 1954, as follows:
- 3 1. By inserting after the second comma (,) in line ten (10) the 4 words "and all amendments thereto".
- 5 2. By inserting after the word "Act" in line eleven (11) the words 6 "and all other Acts pertaining to vocational education".
