## CHAPTER 295

## CLERK OF GRAND JURY

## H. F. 146

AN ACT relating to the salary of the clerk of the grand jury in certain counties.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 SECTION 1. Section seven hundred seventy point twenty-one 2 (770.21), Code 1958, as amended by chapter three hundred seventy-3 five (375), Acts of the Fifty-eighth General Assembly, is hereby 4 amended by striking the last three paragraphs of said section and 5 inserting in lieu thereof the following:

"In all counties having a population of more than seventy-five thousand (75,000) inhabitants and less than one hundred twenty thousand (120,000), each clerk shall receive as compensation, an annual salary of not to exceed four thousand dollars (\$4,000). In counties having a population of one hundred twenty thousand (120,000) and over, and less than one hundred fifty thousand (120,000) inhabitants, each clerk shall receive an annual salary of forty-four hundred dollars (\$4,400). In counties having a population of one hundred fifty thousand (150,000) and over, each clerk shall receive an annual salary of six thousand dollars (\$6,000)."
