### CHAPTER 182.

### REPRESENTATIVE APPORTIONMENT.

AN ACT to apportion the State and define the boundaries of the representative districts therein.

- 1st dis't. SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa, That the county of Allemakee shall constitute the first representative district, and have one representative.
- ad dist. SEC. 2. The county of Winneshiek shall constitute the second representative district, and have one representative.
- ad dist. SEC. 3. The county of Fayette shall constitute the third representative district, and have one representative.

4th dist. SEC. 4. The county of Clayton shall constitute the fourth representative district, and have two representatives.

- 5th dist. SEC. 5. The county of Buchanan and Fayette shall constitute the fifth representative district, and have one representative.
- sth dist. SEC. 6. The county of Black Hawk shall constitute the sixth representative district, and have one representative.
- 7th dist. SEC. 7. The county of Dubuque shall constitute the seventh representative district, and have three representatives.

sth that. SEC. 8. The county of Delaware shall constitute the eighth representative district, and have one representative.

with dist. SEC. 9. The counties of Dubuque, Jones, and Clayton, jointly, shall constitute the ninth representative district, and have one representative.

10th dist. SEC. 10. The county of Benton shall constitute the tenth representative district, and have one representative.

- 11th dist. SEC. 11. The counties of Howard, Ohickasaw and Bremer, jointly, shall constitute the eleventh representative district, and have one representative.
- 12th dist. SEC. 12. The counties of Mitchell, Floyd and Butler, jointly, shall constitute the twelfth representative district, and have one representative.

18th dist. SEC. 13. The counties of Worth, Cerro Gordo, Frank-

lin, Wright, Hancock, Winnebago, Kossuth, Webster, Hamilton, Calhoun, Pocahontas, Palo Alto, Sac, Buena Vista, Clay, Dickinson, and Emmet, jointly, shall constitute the thirteenth representative district, and have one representative.

SEC. 14. The counties of Pottawattamie, Harrison, 14th dust. Shelby, Monona, Crawford, Woodbury, Ida, Plymouth, Cherokee, O'Brien, Osceola, and Buncombe, jointly, shall constitute the fourteenth representative district, and have one representative.

SEC. 15. The counties of Guthrie, Dallas, Cass, Adair, 15th dist. jointly, shall constitute the fifteenth representative district, and have one representative.

SEC. 16. The counties of Boone, Greene, Carroll and 18th dist. Audubon, jointly, shall constitute the sixteenth representative district, and have one representative.

SEC. 17. The counties of Hardin, Grundy and Story,<sup>17th dist.</sup> jointly, shall constitute the seventeenth representative distriict, and have one representative.

SEC. 18. The counties of Tama and Marshall, jointly, <sup>13th</sup> dist. constitute the eighteenth representative district, and have one representative.

SEC. 19. The county of Polk shall constitute the nine-19th dist. teenth representative district, and have one representative.

SEC. 20. The county of Jasper shall constitute the 20th dist. twentieth representative district, and have one representative.

SEC. 21. The counties of Iowa, Powesheik and Ma-21st dist. . haska, shall constitute the twenty-first representative district, and have one representative.

SEC. 22. The county of Johnson shall constitute the 22d dist. twenty-second representative district, and have two representatives.

SEC. 23. The county of Linn shall constitute the twenty-28d dist. third representative district, and have two representatives.

SEC. 24. The county of Jones shall constitute the twen-24th dist. ty-fourth representative district, and have one representative.

SRC. 40. The county of Warren shall constitute the 40th dist. fortieth representative district, and be entitled to one represcritative.

SEC. 41. The county of Madison shall constitute the 41st dist. forty-first representative district, and have one representative.

SEC. 42. The counties of Lucas, ——— jointly, shall 42d dist. constitute the forty-second representative district, and have one representative.

SEC. 43. The counties of Fremont, Mills and Montgom-48d dist. ery, jointly, constitute the forty-third representative district, and shall have one representative.

SEC. 44. The counties of Adams, Union, Page, Taylor, 44th dist. and Ringgold, jointly, shall constitute the forty-fourth representative district, and have one representative.

SEC. 45. The county of Decatur shall constitute the 45th dist. forty-fifth representative district, and have one representative.

SEC. 46. The county of Davis shall constitute the forty-46th dist. sixth representative district, and have one representative.

SEC. 47. The counties of Wayne, Appanoose and Da-47th dist. vis, jointly, shall constitute the forty-seventh representative district, and have one representative.

SEC. 48. The county of Appanoose shall constitute the 48th dist. forty-eighth representative district, and shall have one repsentative.

SEC. 49. The county of Van Buren shall constitute the 49th dist. forty-ninth representative district, and have two representatives.

SEC. 50. The county of Monroe shall constitute the 50th dist. fiftieth representative district, and have one representative.

SEC. 51. The county of Wapello shall constitute the 51st dist. fifty-first representative district, and have two representatives.

## CHAPTER 133.

#### SCHOOL DISTRICT.

AN ACT establishing a school district in Van Buren township, Van Buren county.

Boundary.

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa, That a school district composed of the following described section and parts of section, viz: 16 and 21, (except 40 acres in the south-east corner of said section 21,) and the north half of section 22 and the south half of section 15, be, and the same is hereby established to be subject to all the laws and regulations now in force respecting the organizing of school districts. All acts and parts of acts contrary to the provisions of this act, are hereby repealed.

SEC. 2. This act to take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the Keosauqua Republican and Democratic Mirror, without expense to the State.
