CHAPTER 138.

STATE ROAD.

AN ACT to re-locate part of a State Road.

Names of commissioners.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa, That William F. Morgan, Darius Malony, and John Hunter, of Keokuk county, be, and they are hereby appointed commissioners, to re-locate a part of a State road, leading from Lancaster, in Keokuk county, to Iowaville, in Van Buren county, commencing said change at the southeast corner of the north-east quarter of section 24, in township 74, range 12; thence west, 160 poles; thence north, till it intersects the State road leading from Lancaster, in Keokuk county, to Agency City, in Wapello county; thence with said last named road to Lancaster aforesaid.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect from and after its publication according to law, provided the State incur no expense thereby.

CHAPTER 139.

STATE ROAD.

AN ACT to establish a State Road from Osage, in Mitchell county, by Glenmary and Bristol, to the State line in Worth county.
