CHAPTER, 173

BUBLINGTON SWINE.

AN ACT to prevent swine from running at large in the city of Burlington.

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the Restrain swise State of Iowa, That it shall be unlawful from and after the first of March next, for the owner or owners, possessor or possessors of any hogs, shoats or pigs, to permit such hogs, shoats and pigs to run at large within the corporate limits of the city of Burlington, and any person or persons being the owner or possessor of any swine aforesaid, and permitting them to run at large, contrary to this act, shall be liable to a fine of five dollars for each violation of this act, to Fine. be collected before the mayor or any justice of the peace in said city, as any action for debt, with costs of suit; and such fine shall be paid to the person making complaint.

SEC. 2. This act to take effect from and after its publication in the Iowa State Gazette, and Hawkeye and Telegraph, without expense to the State.

CHAPTER 174.

BRIDGE.

AN ACT to authorize the Burlington and Missouri Biver Railroad Company to construct a bridge across the Mississippi river at Burlington.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the Authorised. State of Iowa, That the Burlington and Missouri River Railroad Company, a corporation existing under and by virtue of the laws of this State, be, and is hereby authorized and empowered to build, maintain and use a Railroad bridge over the Mississipi river, or that portion within the jurisdiction of the State of Iowa, at or near Burlington, in such manner as shall not materially obstruct or interfere Navigation. with the free navigation of said river, and to connect, by railroad or otherwise, such bridge with any railroad in the
