## CHAPTER 176.

## BENTON CITY.

AN ACT to change the numbers of the blocks of lots in the town of Benton city, Benton county, State of Iowa.

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the Change of Nos. State of Iowa, That the numbers of the blocks of lots in the town of Benton City, in the county of Benton and State of Iowa, as designated on the plat thereof as recorded in the office of recorder of deeds and mortgages in and for said county, in Book D, page 20, of the records thereof, be changed as follows, to wit: That block No. 2 shall hereafter be known as block No. 1, and No. 3 as No. 2, and No. 4 as No. 3, and No. 5 as No. 4, and No. 6 as No. 5, and No. 7 as No. 6, and No. 8 as No. 7, and No. 9 as No. 8, and No. 10 as No. 9, and No. 11 as No. 10, and No. 12 as No. 11, and No. 13 as No. 12, and No. 14 as No. 15 as No. 14, and No. 16 as No. 15.

- SEC. 2. That all deeds and conveyances heretofore made Deeds in good faith in accordance with the town plat as now changed, shall be held and considered legal and binding.
- SEC. 3. Provided, however, that this act, with a plat of this act to be said town, shall be filed in the recorder's office, in Benton county, within six months from and after the passage thereof.
- SEO. 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the Iowa City Republican and the Vinton Eagle, without expense to the State.
