CHAPTER 187.

SCHOOL FUND.

AN ACT in relation to the School Fund.

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the sup't pay to State of Iowa, That James D. Eads, superintendent of pub-^{State} treasurlic instruction, is hereby required to pay over to the State t. easurer all monies now in his hands, which may have been, or which shall be paid to him by the school fund commissioner of any county or counties in this State.

SEC. 2. It is hereby made the duty of the treasurer of Treasurer apportion any monies which may be received from the county commissioners, among the several counties, according to chapter sixty-seven, section ten hundred and eighty, of the school laws.

SEC. 3. This act to take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the Iowa Republican and Iowa Capital Reporter.

CHAPTER 188.

AGRICULTURE.

AN ACT for the encouragement of agriculture.

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa, That it shall be the duty of all county agricultural societies in this State, whether now organized or hereafter to be organized, annually to offer and award premiums for the improvement of stock, tillage crops, implements, mechanical fabrics and articles of domestic industry, and such other articles and improvements as they may deem proper.
