

CHAPTER 199.

CONGRESSIONAL DISTRICTS.

AN ACT to change the boundaries of the first and second Congressional districts of the State of Iowa.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa,* That the counties of Des Moines, Louisa, and Washington shall be and are hereby detached from the second Congressional district of the State of Iowa, and attached to the first Congressional district of the same. Counties detached.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect from and after its publication according to law.

CHAPTER 200.

ADDITIONAL JUSTICE OF THE PEACE.

AN ACT requiring the township trustees of Camanche township, Clinton county, to order the election of an additional justice of the peace.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa,* That it is hereby made the duty of the trustees of Camanche township, in Clinton county, to order an election of one justice of the peace at the April election in A. D. 1857, in addition to the two justices now holding office in that township, and that thenceforth there shall be three justices of the peace in said township elected in accordance with existing laws. Trustees order election.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the Iowa City Republican and Iowa Register, without expense to the State.
