where a majority of the legal votes cast in said city at such election, shall be in favor of such measure. The gity council is hereby anthorized and empowered to carry the same into effect according to law and the ordinances of the city : Provided, that in all and every case the said city shall be liable to make full compensation at the fair cash value to the owners of all property, which shall then be taken for public use and for all damages which the owners may sustain by any change which said city council may at any time see proper to make.

Skc. 32. This act to take effect and be in force from and atter its pablication in the St. Charles Republican Intelligencer and Dubuque Tribane.

## CHAPTER 203.

historical society.
AN ACT to pronde for an annual mppropriation for the benetit of a State Bis-
torical Society.
Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the Approprintiom state of Yowa, That there is hereby annually appropristed until the Legislature shall by law otherwise direct, to a State Historical Society, formed or to be formed in connection with, and under the auspices of the State University, the sum of two hundred and fifty dollars, to be expended now expended by said society in collecting, ambodying, arranging and preserving in authentic form, a library of books, pamphlets, mape, charts, manuscripts, papers, paintinge, statuary, and other masterials illustrative of the state of the history of Iowa to rescue from oblivion the memory of its early pioneers, to obtain and preserve varieties of their exploits, perils and hardy adventures; to secure facts and statements relative to the history, genius and progress or decay of our Indian tribes; to exhibit faithfully the antiquities, past and present resources of Iowa; also to aid in the publication of sach of the collections of the society as the society shall 43
from time to time deen of ralue and interest, to aid in binding its books, pamphicte, manscripts and papers, and in paying other neceseny incidental expentes of the society, but mo part of such anmual appropriation shall ever be paid for services rendered by the otticers to the society.
Keep ace'tand Sec. 2. It shall be the duty of the executive committee present tw the Governor. of the said State Ilistorical Society of Iowa to keep an accurate account of the manner of expenditure of the said sum of money herehy appropriated, and furnish the same. together with the ronchers thereof, to the Governor of th:s Etate, in the month of December of the year the Legislatwre shall meet, to be by him laid before the Legislature.

Books and documents.

Sec. 3. There shall be delivertd to said society thirty bound copies of all documents published by order of the State, for the purpose of effecting exchanges with similar societies in other States, and also tifty bound copies of all such documents, to be transmitted through the medium of the eecretary of suid society, to M. Vattemere, at Paris, in furtherance of his system of international literary exchange.

Seo. 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication according to law.

## CHAPTER 204.

OTIS A. HOLMES.
AN ACT to authorize Otis A. Holmes to sell certain lands.
May elll lard. Suction 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa, That Utis A. Holmes be, and hereby is, anthorized to sell such lands as were conveyed to him by Richard Ash in trust for the heirs of said Ash.
Bond
Sec. 2. That said Holmes, before selling said lands, execute a bond to the said heirs by name, in the penal sum of $\$ 2,000$ conditioncd for the failhful sale of said lands and prompt payment of the respective portions of the proceeds of such sale to the said heirs, as they shall severally direct,
