SEC. 4. This act shall be in force from and after its publication in the Fort Madison Plaindealer and Fort Madison Argns newspapers, without cost to the State.

CHAPTER 926.

SALARY OF COUNTY OFFICERS.

AN ACT to amend Sec 211 of Chapter 22 of the Code of Iowa.

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the Amendment to State of Iowa, That all of section two hundred and eleven of chapter twenty second of the Code of Iowa, after the words "five hundred and fifty dollars," be, and the same is hereby repealed, and that the following shall be substituted for the part of said section thus repealed: when the population amounts to six thousand, the salary shall be increased fifty dollars for each additional thousand inhabitants, until the salary reaches the sum of twelve hundred dollars, which shall be the highest salary paid to any of the officers named in said section.

SEC. 2. That all parts of said chapter 22 conflicting Bepeal. herewith, be, and the same is hereby repealed.

SEC. 3. This act to be in force from and after its publication in the Iowa City Republican and Capital Reporter.
