- SEC. 4. There is hereby appropriated out of the general fund to Wayne A. Faupel the sum of six hundred and twenty-five dollars There is hereby appropriated out of the general fund to 2 3 (\$625.00), for each year of the biennium, for extra services.
- SEC. 5. The state comptroller is hereby authorized to make avail-2 able any unexpended balance of the appropriation of eight thousand
- five hundred dollars (\$8,500.00) made to the executive council in chapter fifty, Acts of the Fifty-ninth General Assembly, for legis-
- lative expenses in order that such balance may be applied to the pay-
- 6 ment of legislative expenses of the Sixtieth General Assembly.
- SEC. 6. This Act, being deemed of immediate importance, shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication
- in the New Hampton Tribune, a newspaper published in New Hamp-
- ton, Iowa, and in The Atlantic News-Telegraph, a newspaper pub-
- lished in Atlantic, Iowa.

CHAPTER 55

GENERAL CONTINGENT FUND

S. F. 460

AN ACT creating the general contingent fund of the state for the biennium beginning July 1, 1963, and appropriating thereto the sum of two million dollars (\$2,000,000,000) from the general fund of the state, specifying the purposes for which the appropriation may be used, and providing for a report of the dispositions made of the fund.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

SECTION 1. The general contingent fund of the state for the biennium beginning July 1, 1963, and ending June 30, 1965, is hereby created and said fund shall consist of the sum of two million dollars 3 (\$2,000,000.00) hereby appropriated thereto from the general fund of the state. Said contingent fund shall be administered by the budget and financial control committee and allocation therefrom may be made only for contingencies arising during the biennium which are legally payable from the funds of the state. Allocations may be made for compensation and expense of members of the budget and financial 8 control committee, authorized by section two point forty-five (2.45), 10

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- Code 1962, and for the payment of obligations incurred under the 11 provisions of subsection six (6) of section two point forty-four (2.44), 12 Code 1962, and section two point forty-six (2.46), Code 1962. The 13 budget and financial control committee shall not allocate any funds for any purpose or project which was presented to the general as-14 15 sembly by way of a bill and which failed to become enacted into law. 16 17 A report of the dispositions made of the fund during the first eighteen months of the biennium shall be made by the budget and financial control committee to the state comptroller prior to the convening of 18 19 20 the Sixty-first General Assembly and by him included in the printed budget. Any balance in said contingent fund as of June 30, 1965, shall
- 22 revert to the general fund of the state. SEC. 2. Section two point sixty-two (2.62), Code 1962, is hereby amended by striking the sentence beginning with the word "All" in
