## CHAPTER 126

## LICENSED PHARMACIST TO FILL PRESCRIPTION

- AN ACT to amend sections one hundred fifty-five point two (155.2) and one hundred fifty-five point six (155.6), Code 1962, regarding the right of unlicensed persons to fill prescriptions.
- Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:
- SECTION 1. Section one hundred fifty-five point two (155.2), Code 1962, is hereby amended by striking all of subsection one (1) and by renumbering the remaining subsections.
  - SEC. 2. Section one hundred fifty-five point six (155.6), Code 1962, is hereby repealed and the following inserted in lieu thereof:
- 2 "No unlicensed person or licensed pharmacist shall allow anyone who 3
- is not a licensed pharmacist to fill the prescriptions of licensed physi-4 cians, dentists or veterinarians, except a person who is registered with 5
- the board of pharmacy examiners pursuant to the practical experience 6 requirements of this chapter and unless the same be done under the
- immediate personal supervision of a licensed pharmacist. All drugs 8
- and medicines requiring a prescription which are sold, exposed or 9 offered for sale shall be under the immediate personal supervision of 10
- a licensed pharmacist at all times except for temporary absences. 11
- 12 However, during a period of temporary absence of a licensed pharma-
- 13 cist no drugs or medicines requiring a prescription shall be sold or
- offered for sale in the pharmacy except proprietary medicines or do-14
- mestic remedies." 15
