CHAPTER 327

FALSE USE OF CREDIT CARDS

H. F. 257

AN ACT making it a misdemeanor to obtain or attempt to obtain goods, property or service by false or fraudulent use of credit cards or other false or fraudulent means, and providing penalties therefor.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

SECTION 1. It shall be unlawful for any person knowingly to obtain or attempt to obtain credit, or to purchase or attempt to purchase any 3 goods, property or service, by the use of any false, fictitious, counterfeit or expired credit card, telephone number, credit number or other credit device, or by the use of any credit card, telephone number, 6 credit number or other credit device of another without the authority of the person to whom such card, number or device was issued, or by the use of any credit card, telephone number, credit number or other 8 9 credit device in any case where such card, number or device has been 10 revoked and notice of revocation has been given to the person to whom 11 issued.

SEC. 2. It shall be unlawful for any person to obtain or attempt to obtain, by the use of any fraudulent scheme, device, means or method, telephone or telegraph service or the transmission of a message, signal or other communication by telephone or telegraph, or over telephone or telegraph facilities with intent to avoid payment of charges therefor.

- SEC. 3. The word "notice" as used in section one (1) of this Act shall be a notice given in writing to the person to whom the number, card or device was issued. The sending of a notice in writing by registered or certified mail in the United States mail, duly stamped and addressed to such person at his last address known to the issuer, shall
- be evidence that such notice was duly received.
- SEC. 4. Any person who violates any provision of section one (1) or section two (2) of this Act shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction shall be punished by a fine of not more than one hundred dollars (\$100.00) or imprisonment for not more than thirty (30) days, or by both such fine and imprisonment.

HUNTING ON LAND OF ANOTHER

S. F. 10

AN ACT relating to unlawful hunting on land of another.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

SECTION 1. Section seven hundred fourteen point twenty-five (714.25), Code 1962, is hereby amended by inserting after the word "dog" in line two (2) the words ", bow and arrow,".

CHAPTER 329

PENALTY FOR TRESPASS BY HUNTING OR FISHING

H. F. 4

AN ACT relating to hunting and fishing upon cultivated or inclosed lands and waters. Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section seven hundred fourteen point twenty-five 2 (714.25), Code 1962, is hereby amended by striking from line ten (10)
- 3 of such section the word "ten" and inserting in lieu thereof the words 4 "one hundred".
