Where any provisions of the law of this state are in con-2 flict with this Act the provisions of this Act shall govern for the biennium.

- SEC. 3. All salaries provided for in this Act shall be payable in equal monthly or semi-monthly installments, and shall be in full compensation for all services except as otherwise expressly provided and except further that expense allowances shall be authorized, any ruling of the Federal Internal Revenue Service with respect to the tax status thereof notwithstanding.
- SEC. 4. No funds appropriated by this Act, or receipts, which may be used for the same purpose as said appropriation, may be used for capital improvements.

SEC. 5. Chapter eight (8), Code 1962, shall apply to this Act, except that employees whose salaries are appropriated herein shall not come under the division of personnel under section eight point five (8.5), Code 1962.

AN ACT to appropriate from the general fund of the state of Iowa for capital improvements for institutions under the board of control, including construction of new buildings, repairs, improvements, replacements or alterations, and providing for joint control for the expenditure thereof by the board of control, the governor, and the state comptroller and to authorize and direct the sale of excess institutional farm land and farm equipment under the jurisdiction of the board of control.

SEC. 2. The board of control is hereby authorized and directed with the approval of the executive council to sell the excess institutional farm land and farm equipment referred to (but not limited to) in the Doane Agricultural Report to the board of control dated February 1965.

Two million six hundred five thousand dollars (\$2,605,000.00) of the proceeds to be derived from the sale of institutional farm land, farm equipment and production herds, less the three hundred thirty-four thousand dollars (\$334,000.00) of the proceeds from the sale of the Clive prison honor farm as provided by chapter three hundred seventy-four (374), Acts of the Sixtieth General Assembly, shall be credited to the appropriation provided by this Act to supplement items
