"There is hereby created as a permanent fund in the office of the 3 treasurer of state a fund to be known as the governors' elect expense 4 fund. For the purpose of establishing and maintaining said fund, for 5 each biennium, beginning July 1, 1965, there is hereby appropriated thereto from funds in the general fund not otherwise appropriated the sum of ten thousand dollars (\$10,000.00), or so much thereof as may be necessary, to pay for office space, supplies, postage, and secretarial and clerical salaries after the day of the election and before the day of 8 9 10 the inauguration for a first term governor-elect. Any balance in said 11 fund at the end of each biennium shall revert to the general fund. Said 12 fund shall be subject at all times to the warrant of the state comptroller, drawn upon written requisition of the governor-elect. In event 13 14 of a contested election, no distribution of the fund will be made until 15 such time as the general assembly certifies the results of the election. 16

CHAPTER 63

INAUGURAL APPROPRIATION

S. F. 542

AN ACT to appropriate funds to defray expenses of the inaugural ceremonies.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

- SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated out of funds of the state treasury not otherwise appropriated in the sum of nine thousand one hundred eight dollars eighty-eight cents (\$9,108.88) or so much there-of as may be necessary, to pay the expenses incurred on account of the inaugural ceremonies and reception.
- Warrants shall be drawn upon the treasury for the sum herein appropriated in favor of the adjutant general upon the filing of vouchers therefor with the state comptroller.
- SEC. 2. This Act, being deemed of immediate importance, shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and publication in The Fort Dodge Messenger, a newspaper published at Fort Dodge, Iowa, and in The West Des Moines Express, a newspaper published at West Des Moines, Iowa.
