SCHOOL SUPPLIES

AN ACT to amend section two hundred seventy-nine point twenty-five (279.25), Code 1962, relating to purchase of school supplies.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

- SECTION 1. Section two hundred seventy-nine point twenty-five
- (279.25), Code 1962, is amended by striking from lines seven (7) to nine (9) the words "to an amount not exceeding two hundred dollars in any one year" and inserting in lieu thereof the words "as deemed necessary by the board of directors".

CHAPTER 246

EYE PROTECTIVE DEVICES

S. F. 228

AN ACT to require the wearing of eye protective devices by students and teachers.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

- f. Caustic or explosive materials; 12
- 13 2. Chemical or combined chemical-physical laboratories involving
- caustic or explosive chemicals or hot liquids or solids when risk is in-14
- volved; is required to wear industrial quality eye protective devices at 15
- all times while participating in any phase or activity of such course 16
- which may subject the student or teacher to the risk or hazard of eye 17
