SEC. 2. All federal grants to and the federal receipts of these departments and divisions thereof are hereby appropriated for the purpose set forth in such federal grants or receipts.

Sec. 3. No moneys appropriated by this Act shall be used for capital improvements, except such expenditures as may be made in connection with maintenance and training facilities required by the Military Division, Department of Public Defense.

SEC. 4. There is hereby transferred to the general fund of the state the sum of twenty-one thousand six hundred $(21,600)$ dollars from the special fund created and existing under the provisions of section one hundred twenty-four point five (124.5) of the Code, as amended by chapter one hundred fifty-five (155), section seven (7), Acts of the Sixty-second General Assembly. Act, the provisions of this Act shall govern for the biennium.
