AN ACT to appropriate from moneys received by certain commissions, boards, and departments.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

A contingency shall exclude any purpose or project which was $\mathbf{2}$ presented to the general assembly by way of a bill and which failed to be-3 come enacted into law, however, for the purpose of this Act an unforeseen necessity of additional operating funds may be construed as a contingency. 4

1 Before any of the funds appropriated by this Act shall be allo-SEC. 4. $\mathbf{2}$ cated for contingencies it shall be determined by the executive council that 3 a contingency exists and that the proposed allocation shall be for the best 4 interest of the state.

If the full amounts authorized in section one (1) are not ex-1 Sec. 5. $\mathbf{2}^{-}$ pended during the first year, the unused portion shall carry forward and be 3 an addition to the amount authorized for the second year of the biennium.

The provisions of chapter eight (8) of the Code shall apply to SEC. 6. 1 2this Act.

SEC. 7. Where any of the laws of this state are in conflict with this 1 2 Act, the provisions of this Act shall govern for the biennium.

CHAPTER 7

AERONAUTICS COMMISSION

AN ACT to appropriate from moneys received by the Iowa aeronautics commission.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

For the Iowa aeronautics commission there is hereby ap-1 Section 1. propriated all funds received in the state aviation fund for the biennium beginning July 1, 1969 and ending June 30, 1971. The following amount, $\mathbf{2}$ 3 4 or so much thereof as may be necessary, is authorized to be expended from said receipts for each year of the biennium to be used in the manner $\mathbf{5}$ 6 designated:
