- Any unencumbered balance remaining as of June 30, 1971, of the appropriation of this section shall revert to the general fund of the state as of June 30, 1971.
- 1 Sec. 3. All federal grants to and the federal receipts of these depart-2 ments and divisions thereof are hereby appropriated for the purpose set 3 forth in such federal grants or receipts.
- 1 Sec. 4. Where any of the laws of this state are in conflict with this Act, 2 the provisions of this Act shall govern for the biennium.

## CHAPTER 27

## DIVISION OF STATE PLANNING

## S. F. 609

AN ACT to appropriate from the general fund of the state of Iowa to the division of state planning in the governor's office for community action local aid programs, various governor's study committees and for community affairs.

## Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

- There is hereby appropriated from the general fund of the 2 state of Iowa to the division of state planning in the governor's office for each year of the biennium beginning July 1, 1969 and ending June 30, 1971, 3 the following amounts, or so much thereof as may be necessary, to be used 5 in the manner designated: For support of community action local aid programs 6 7 For study committees ...... 8 50,000.00 9 For community affairs 25,000.00 10
- 1 Sec. 2. Any unused balance of the funds herein appropriated remaining 2 at the end of the biennium shall revert to the general fund of the state.
- 1 Sec. 3. The funds appropriated under section one (1) of this Act shall become available upon the effective date of this Act for the first year of the biennium.
- SEC. 4. This Act, being deemed of immediate importance, shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication in the Marshalltown Times-Republican, a newspaper published at Marshalltown, Iowa, and The Sheffield Press, a newspaper published at Sheffield, Iowa.
