MOTOR VEHICLE DEALERS LICENSES

S. F. 663

AN ACT to appropriate from moneys received by the department of public safety motor vehicle dealers license fee fund.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

- Section 1. For the department of public safety motor vehicle dealers license fee fund, there is hereby appropriated all funds received under authority of chapter three hundred twenty-two (322) of the Code, for the biennium beginning July 1, 1969 and ending June 30, 1971. The following amount, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is authorized to be expended from said receipts for each year of the biennium to be used in the 7 manner designated: 8 For salaries, support, maintenance, equipment 9 \$91.110.00 and miscellaneous purposes
- 1 The remainder of the fund referred to in section one (1) of this Act is hereby appropriated for contingencies arising during the biennium which are legally payable from the fund.
- A contingency shall exclude any purpose or project which was presented to the general assembly by way of a bill and which failed to become enacted into law, however, for the purpose of this Act a necessity of additional operating funds may be construed as a contingency.
- 1 Before any of the funds appropriated by this Act shall be allocated for contingencies it shall be determined by the executive council that a contingency exists and that the proposed allocation shall be for the best interest of the state.
- 1 If the full amount authorized in section one (1) is not expended during the first year, the unused portion shall carry forward and be an addition to the amount authorized for the second year of the biennium.
- The provisions of chapter eight (8) of the Code shall apply to Sec. 6. 2 this Act.
- Where any of the laws of this state are in conflict with this Act, the provisions of this Act shall govern for the biennium.
