CHAPTER 64

LEGISLATIVE RESEARCH BUREAU

S. F. 607

AN ACT to make an appropriation to the Iowa legislative research bureau for updating the Code of Iowa on magnetic tape and to revise the related vocabulary concordance.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from the general fund of 1 2 the state to the Iowa legislative research bureau the sum of thirteen thou-3 sand (13,000) dollars, or so much thereof as shall be necessary, for the pur-4 pose of incorporating the Acts of the Sixty-third General Assembly into 5 the Code of Iowa on magnetic tape and to update and revise the related 6 vocabulary concordance. The incorporation of the Acts on tape and the 7 updating and revision of the vocabulary concordance shall be accomplished in such manner as approved by the Iowa legislative research com-8 9 mittee. Any unused balance of the funds herein appropriated remaining 10 upon completion of the project authorized by this Act shall revert to the 11 general fund of the state.
