CHAPTER 174

SPECIAL EDUCATION SERVICES

S. F. 409

AN ACT relating to the requirement that school districts make provision for special education services to all children enrolled in the public schools.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 SECTION 1. Section two hundred fifty-seven point twenty-five (257.25), 2 Code 1966, as amended by chapters two hundred twenty-seven (227), two 3 hundred twenty-eight (228), and two hundred twenty-nine (229), Acts of 4 the Sixty-second General Assembly, is hereby further amended by inserting 5 after subsection four (4) the following new subsection:

6 "Provision for special education services and programs, which may be 7 shared by public schools, shall be made for children requiring special educa-8 tion, who are or would otherwise be enrolled in kindergarten through 9 grade eight of such schools."

1 SEC. 2. Chapter two hundred eighty (280), Code 1966, is hereby amend-2 ed by adding thereto the following new section:

"The board in each school district shall make provision whereby special 3 education services are made available to all handicapped pupils enrolled 4 in kindergarten and all grades of its schools. Programs offered under this 5section shall comply with rules and standards promulgated by the state 6 board of public instruction and shall be subject to approval and reimburse-7 ment of excess costs as provided in chapter two hundred eighty-one (281) 8 of the Code. Programs offered under this section may be carried on by co-9 10 operative arrangements between districts and county boards of education 11 as provided by chapter two hundred eighty-one (281) of the Code.'

CHAPTER 175

PUBLIC INSTRUCTION FEDERAL PROGRAMS

S. F. 680

AN ACT to establish permanent revolving funds for the department of public instruction for administering federally financed programs and to make appropriations therefor.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter two hundred fifty-seven (257), Code 1966, is hereby 2 amended by adding thereto the following section:

³ "There is hereby established a permanent revolving fund to be known as ⁴ the 'veterans education administration revolving fund'. From this fund ⁵ shall be paid the salary and travel expenses of department of public instruc-⁶ tion personnel supervising the veterans education program which will be ⁷ reimbursed by the veterans administration of the federal government. There ⁸ is hereby appropriated from the general fund of the state to the department ⁹ of public instruction the sum of seven thousand five hundred (7,500) dol-¹⁰ lars for the purpose of establishing the fund. 11 If any surplus accrues to said revolving fund in excess of the original 12 appropriation for which there is no anticipated need or use, the governor 13 shall order such surplus to be deposited in the general fund."

1 SEC. 2. Chapter two hundred eighty-three A (283A), Code 1966, is 2 hereby amended by adding thereto the following section:

3 "There is hereby established a permanent revolving fund for the depart-4 ment of public instruction to be known as the 'school lunch revolving $\mathbf{5}$ fund'. From this fund shall be paid the cost of warehousing, handling and transportation of direct distribution of federal surplus commodities. The 6 $\overline{7}$ fund shall be reimbursed by pro rata cost of items to receiving schools and institutions. There is hereby appropriated from the general fund of the 8 9 state to the department of public instruction the sum of five thousand (5,000) dollars for the purpose of carrying out this section. 10

11 If any surplus accrues to said revolving fund in excess of the original 12 appropriation for which there is no anticipated need or use, the governor 13 shall order such surplus to be deposited in the general fund."

CHAPTER 176

VOCATIONAL EDUCATION ADVISORY COUNCIL

S.F. 544

AN ACT to establish a state advisory council for vocational education.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 SECTION 1. Section two hundred fifty-eight point seven (258.7), Code 2 1966, is hereby repealed and the following enacted in lieu thereof:

3 "There is hereby established a state advisory council for vocational 4 education, consisting of thirteen members, which shall be appointed by the 5 governor. The term of each member shall be for three years, except that for 6 the initial appointments the governor shall specify the terms of each mem-7 ber so that as nearly as possible, the terms of an equal number of members 8 shall expire on the first day of July of each year.

9 The advisory council shall serve in an advisory capacity to the state 10 board and shall perform such functions as may be necessary in order for 11 the state of Iowa to qualify for federal aids and grants to vocational educa-12 tion.

13 The advisory council shall include members who are:

14 1. Familiar with the vocational needs and the problems of manage-15 ment and labor in the state.

16 2. Representative of state industrial and economic development agencies. 17 3. Representative of community and junior colleges and other institu-18 tions of higher education, area vocational schools, technical institutes, and 19 postsecondary or adult education institutions, which provide programs of 20 vocational or technical education and training.

21 4. Familiar with the administration of state and local vocational edu-22 cation programs.

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
