

## CHAPTER 214

## MOTOR VEHICLE RECIPROCITY CAB CARDS

## H. F. 3

AN ACT relating to issuance of a single cab card for vehicles subject to the provisions of chapter three hundred twenty-six (326) of the Code.

*Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*

1 SECTION 1. When used in this Act, unless the context otherwise re-  
2 quires:

3 1. "Executive secretary" shall mean the person appointed by the Iowa  
4 reciprocity board in accordance with chapter three hundred twenty-six  
5 (326) of the Code.

6 2. "Participating agencies" shall mean the Iowa reciprocity board, the  
7 department of revenue, the Iowa state commerce commission, and the de-  
8 partment of public safety.

9 3. "Single cab card" shall mean the single document issued pursuant to  
10 this chapter to indicate compliance with the various applicable require-  
11 ments of the participating agencies.

12 4. "Carrier" shall include, where applicable, natural persons, corpora-  
13 tions, trusts, unincorporated associations, and partnerships.

1 SEC. 2. Any carrier who operates vehicles subject to the provisions of  
2 chapter three hundred twenty-six (326) of the Code may, in lieu of carrying  
3 evidence of compliance with the separate participating agencies, elect to  
4 carry a single cab card indicating evidence of compliance with all require-  
5 ments of the participating agencies which must be carried within the cab  
6 of the vehicle. No fee shall be charged for the single cab card, but this  
7 section shall not be construed to waive any fees imposed by law or re-  
8 quired by the participating agencies. All single cab cards shall expire on  
9 December thirty-first of each year.

1 SEC. 3. Upon compliance with the respective requirements of each  
2 participating agency by a carrier electing to carry the single cab card, a  
3 certificate of compliance shall be conveyed by the participating agency to  
4 the executive secretary. Upon receipt of the certificates of compliance,  
5 the executive secretary shall issue a single cab card which shall indicate  
6 compliance with all requirements of the participating agencies. If a certifi-  
7 cate of compliance is withdrawn by any one of the participating agencies,  
8 the executive secretary shall cancel the single cab card.

1 SEC. 4. The executive secretary may issue a temporary authorization  
2 permit to qualified carriers for vehicles not previously issued a permanent  
3 single cab card. Such temporary permit shall be valid until the issuance of  
4 a single cab card or cancellation of the permit by the executive secretary  
5 upon apprehension for violation of any requirements enforceable by each  
6 participating agency.

1 SEC. 5. The participating agencies shall jointly prepare and adopt  
2 rules and regulations to effectuate the purposes of this Act.
