# CHAPTER 304

#### AMATEUR BOXING

#### S. F. 484

AN ACT relating to amateur boxing.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

- 2 Code 1966, is hereby amended by adding thereto the words "This section
- 3 shall not apply to amateur boxing."

### CHAPTER 305

## ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS OF LIQUOR COMMISSION

# H. F. 318

AN ACT vesting police powers and the status of peace officers upon agents, officers, and investigators of the enforcement division of the Iowa liquor control commission.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section seven hundred forty-eight point three (748.3), Code 2 1966, is hereby amended as follows:
- 3 1. By inserting after subsection five (5) the following new subsection:
- 4 "Agents, officers, and investigators of the enforcement division of the Iowa 5 liquor control commission."

6 2. By renumbering the remaining subsection.
