CHAPTER 1060

GREEN VALLEY LAKE

H. F. 91

AN ACT to permit the conservation commission to promulgate, for experimental purposes, special rules relating to the operation of watercraft and other water-oriented activity on Green Valley Lake, near the city of Creston.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 SECTION 1. Section one hundred six point thirty-one (106.31), 2 Code 1966, is hereby amended by adding the following new subsection:

3 "The conservation commission may, for experimental purposes,

4 promulgate special rules to regulate operation of watercraft and other 5 water-oriented activity on Green Valley Lake, near the city of Creston

6 in Union county. Said special rules may include rules relating to:

7 a. Zoning in regards to area, activity, boat speed, and time of day 8 during which specified activities shall be permitted.

9 b. Permissible horsepower, size, and type of watercraft which may 10 be operated.

11 c. Safety precautions and practices required.

12 The conservation commission may at any time rescind any rules or

regulations previously promulgated in accordance with this subsection.
Subsection one (1) of this section shall not apply to said Green
Valley Lake."

1 SEC. 2. The conservation commission may at any time prohibit

2 water skiing if it finds such activities to be damaging to the shoreline 3 of Green Valley Lake.
