The provisions of this compact shall be severable 232 and if any phrase, clause, sentence or provision of this compact 233 is declared to be contrary to the constitution of any party state or 234 of the United States or the applicability thereof to any government, 235 agency, person or circumstance is held invalid, the validity of the 236 remainder of this compact and the applicability thereof to any gov-237 ernment, agency, person or circumstance shall not be affected thereby. 238 If this compact shall be held contrary to the constitution of any state 239 party thereto, the compact shall remain in full force and effect as 240 to the remaining states and in full force and effect as to the state 241affected as to all severable matters."
