In all other respects the provisions of section eight point thirty-three (8.33) of the Code shall apply to appropriations 6  $\overline{7}$ made for the first fiscal year of such biennium. Unencumbered or 8 unobligated balances of appropriations made for the second fiscal year 9 of such biennium shall be subject to section eight point thirty-three 10(8.33) of the Code. 11

## CHAPTER 66

### PUBLIC SAFETY DEPARTMENT

## H. F. 764

AN ACT to appropriate from moneys received by the department of public safety motor vehicle dealers license fee fund.

## Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

There is appropriated and the commissioner of public  $\mathbf{2}$ safety may expend from the money received by the department of 3 public safety under section three hundred twenty-two point twelve (322.12) of the Code, known as the motor vehicle dealers license fee fund, for each year of the biennium beginning July 1, 1973 and ending 4 5 June 30, 1975 the following amounts, or so much thereof as may be 6 7 necessary, to be used for the following purposes:
