- Section 1. There is appropriated from the general fund of the state for the biennium fiscal period beginning July 1, 1971, and ending June 30, 1973 1974, to the state historical society the sum of twelve thousand (12,000) dollars, or so much thereof as may be necessary, to be used for further development of Toolsboro Mounds and museum area, and the sum of eight thousand (8,000) dollars, or so much thereof as may be necessary, to be used for further development and maintenance of Gardner Log Cabin.
- 1 SEC. 2. Acts of the Sixty-fourth General Assembly, 1971 Session, 2 chapter thirty-six (36), section three (3), is amended to read as follows:
- Sec. 3. Any unencumbered balance remaining as of June 30, 1973 1974, of the appropriation of this Act shall revert to the general fund of the state as of June 30, 1973 1974.

CHAPTER 85

CONSERVATION COMMISSION

H. F. 805

AN ACT making an appropriation to the state conservation commission for support of the Missouri River riverfront project.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

- 1 SECTION 1. There is appropriated from the general fund of the 2 state to the state conservation commission for the fiscal year begin-
- 3 ning July 1, 1973 and ending June 30, 1974 the sum of thirty thousand 4 (30,000) dollars, or so much thereof as may be necessary, to be used
- 5 for the state's contribution for the support of the Missouri River
- 6 riverfront project.
- SEC. 2. Unencumbered funds as of June 30, 1974 appropriated by this Act shall revert to the general fund of the state on August 31, 1974.
