- SEC. 5. Any unencumbered balance of the funds appropriated by section one (1) of this Act remaining as of June 30, 1975 shall revert to the general fund of the state as of September 30, 1975.
- 1 SEC. 6. When any of the laws of this state are in conflict with this 2 Act, the provisions of this Act shall govern for the biennium.
- \*Approved June 3, 1974 except the item designated as Section 2 herein which is delineated with my reasons in my veto message to the Secretary of State this same date, a copy of which is attached hereto, which I hereby disapprove.

AN ACT to make an appropriation from the general fund of the state to the state historical society.

SECTION 1. There is appropriated from the general fund of the

- SEC. 3. All federal grants to and the federal receipts of the agency receiving funds under this Act are appropriated for the purpose set forth in the federal grants or receipts.
- SEC. 4. Unencumbered funds appropriated by this Act as of June 30, 1975 shall revert to the general fund of the state on September 30, 1975.
