- 3 Conforming standards. In addition to complying with the standards and specifications set forth in sections 104A.3 and 104A.4, 4 the authority responsible for the construction of any building or facil-5 ity covered by section 104A.2 shall insofar as feasible in the opinion of 6 the contracting authority conform with the standards and specifica-7 tions approved by American Standards Association, Inc. on October 31, 8 1961, known as "American Standard Specifications for Making Build-9 ings and Facilities Accessible to and Usable by the Physically Handi-10 capped, A-117.1-1961" rules and regulations promulgated by the state 11 building code commissioner as provided in section one hundred three A 12 point seven (103A.7) of the Code. 13
  - Section one hundred three A point seven (103A.7), unnum-1 2 bered paragraph two (2), paragraph five (5), Code 1973, is amended 3 to read as follows:
  - 5. The accessibility and use by physically handicapped and elderly persons, of buildings, structures, and facilities which are constructed 4 5 in whole er part with public funds and are intended for use by the 6 7 general public.
- SEC. 6. The standards and specifications extending the provisions 2 of chapter one hundred four A (104A) of the Code to private buildings 3 and facilities which are intended for use by the general public and the additional standards to chapter one hundred four A (104A) of the 4 5 Code provided by this Act, shall apply to all public and private buildings intended for use by the general public, the construction of which commences on or after January 1, 1975 or the construction of which is 6 continuing on January 1, 1975, unless the state building code commis-8 sioner shall determine that the construction has reached a state in 9 which compliance will result in a substantial increase in cost or delay 10 11 in construction.

## CHAPTER 1120 WATER NAVIGATION

H. F. 282

AN ACT relating to water navigation regulations.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

- SECTION 1. Section one hundred six point two (106.2), Code 1973, 2 is amended by adding the following new subsection:
- NEW SUBSECTION. "Wake" means any movement of water created by a vessel which adversely affects the activities of another person who 3 4 5 is involved in activities approved for that area or which may adversely

affect the natural features of the shoreline.
