EXPENSES OF PERSONS SEEKING EMPLOYMENT

S. F. 521

AN ACT relating to expenses for persons seeking or employed in positions with the state. Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter seventy-nine (79), Code 1975, is amended by 2 adding the following new section:

3 NEW SECTION. Interview or moving expenses. If approved by 4 the appointing or employing authority, a person who interviews for a $\mathbf{5}$ position with the state shall be reimbursed for expenses incurred in the 6 interview at the same rate provided for state employees for reimburse- $\mathbf{7}$ ment for expenses for state business. If approved by the appointing or 8 employing authority, a person who is hired in a position with the state shall receive reimbursement for moving expenses incurred after the 9 10 time the person is hired. However, expenses incurred in moving this 11 person's household goods and other personal effects shall be reimbursed only to the extent the expense is for the packing and moving of ten 12 13 thousand pounds or less of these goods and effects. Also, reimburse-14 ment for moving expenses shall not include reimbursement for the ex-15pense of moving animals.

CHAPTER 84

HIGHWAY PATROL

H. F. 6

AN ACT relating to political affiliations of highway safety patrol personnel.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 SECTION 1. Section eighty point four (80.4), Code 1975, is amended 2 to read as follows:

80.4 Highway patrol. The Iowa highway safety patrol established in the department of public safety shall consist of a complement of not to exceed four hundred ten persons, not more than sixty percent of whom shall at any time be members of the same political party.
