EXECUTIVE COUNCIL, AUDITOR, TREASURER AND INSURANCE DEPARTMENT

H. F. 1216

AN ACT appropriating funds to certain executive agencies including the executive council, the auditor of state, treasurer of state, and insurance department.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

SECTION 1. There is appropriated from the general fund of the state to the following departments for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1976, and ending June 3 30, 1977, the following amounts, or so much thereof as may be necessary, to be 4 used for the following purposes: 5 1976-77 6 Fiscal Year 7 1. EXECUTIVE COUNCIL For salaries, support, maintenance and miscellaneous purposes.....\$ 8 16,710 2. AUDITOR OF STATE 10 For salaries, support, maintenance and miscellaneous purposes\$ 1,091,309 3. TREASURER OF STATE 11 12 For salaries, support, maintenance and miscellaneous purposes.....\$ 296,000 13 4. INSURANCE DEPARTMENT OF IOWA 14 For salaries, support, maintenance and miscellaneous purposes...... \$ 1,362,309 SEC. 2. Section nineteen point seven (19.7)*, unnumbered paragraph two (2), 2 Code 1975, is amended to read as follows: 3 The proceeds of such loan shall be applied toward the payment of costs and obligations necessitated by such actual or potential disaster and the reimbursement of local funds from which such expenditures have been made. 4 Any such project for repair, rebuilding or restoration of state property for which no specific appropriation has been made, shall, before work is begun thereon, be subject to approval or rejection by the executive council. The executive council may incur expenses necessary to perform or cause to be performed duties imposed on the council by this section and may pay such expenses from money in the state 10 11 treasury not otherwise appropriated.

SEC. 3. All federal grants to and the federal receipts of the agencies appropriated funds under this Act are appropriated for the purposes set forth in such federal grants or receipts.

SEC. 4. Funds appropriated by this Act shall not be used for capital improvements.
